

**NOTICE of SPECIAL ELECTION
of the
HUBBARDSVILLE FIRE DISTRICT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election of the Hubbardsville Fire District (Fire District) will take place on **Tuesday August 27, 2019 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.** at the Hubbardsville Fire Department located at 8162 Green Road Hubbardsville, NY 13355. Qualified voters of the Fire District may vote concerning Proposition 1, a resolution approved by the Board of Fire Commissioners on July 17, 2019 subject to mandatory referendum authorizing the issuance of Fire District bonds in an amount not to exceed \$585,000 for the purpose of financing the purchase of an Engine Tanker firefighting apparatus for the extinguishment and prevention of fires. Proposition 1 reads substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION NUMBER 1

Shall the bond resolution adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Hubbardsville Fire District in the Town of Hamilton, County of Madison, State of New York on July 17, 2019, authorizing the acquisition of a certain Engine Tanker fire apparatus including incidental equipment and expenses in connection therewith at an estimated maximum cost of \$585,000.00; authorizing the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$50,000 from the Fire District's Capital Equipment Reserve Fund; authorizing the issuance of serial bonds of said Fire District at the prevailing rate of interest at the time of closing in an amount not to exceed \$535,000.00 to pay a portion of the costs thereof, such amount to be offset by any federal, state, county, and/or local funds received; pledging the faith and credit of said Fire District for the payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds; determining the period of probable usefulness said apparatus is twenty (20) years; determining that the maximum maturity of serial bonds will be fifteen (15) years; delegating the power to authorize and sell bond anticipation notes and to fix the details of and to sell serial bonds or statutory installment bonds; providing for the levy of a tax upon the taxable property within the fire district to be collected to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds; containing an estoppel clause and providing for the publication of an estoppel notice, be approved?

Only those persons who are residents of the Hubbardsville Fire District on or before July 29, 2019 and who are registered to vote with the Madison County Board of Elections on or before August 5, 2019 shall be eligible to vote in this Special Election.
